David Carlson opened the meeting at 1:30 pm. Members introduced themselves and stated the constituency that they represented.

Discussion of Computer Use Policies

Two handouts were distributed. One handout was the proposed computer use policy. The other was the current use policy, as approved by the Board of Trustees at the 9/11 meeting.

Don Olson reported an external audit of IT in the spring of 2003. These audits typically occur every 3rd year. The focus of this particular audit was disaster recovery and security. The Carbondale campus looked relatively good in the physical security category. All doors to IT are locked with card reader systems. The audit did suggest that backup security was not sufficient. It recommended backup from tapes and documentation of the backup process. IT now documents all systems failures to aid in finding ways to solve reoccurring problems.
